Late entries will not be accepted. Poultry shown in the 4H/FFA show cannot be shown in the Open Class Show. Double-cooping is required for xtra-large breed chickens and large breed cockerels and cockbirds; add \$1.00 for each double coop.

I will read and follow all of the rules of the La Plata County Fair. I will also read and follow the Colorado State Law concerning the unlawful alteration of livestock, where applicable, by tampering or sabotage and the United State Department of Agriculture Wholesome Meat Act. I will ask that my parents and supervisors also understand and follow these rules and not make or ask for exceptions on my behalf. I wish my animal project to be an example of how to accept what life has to offer – good or bad – and how to live with the outcome. I understand that I am responsible for the proper care and treatment of my animal, the production of wholesome food, where applicable, and the development of sound moral character.

The care, feeding, health, and safety of animals brought to the La Plata County Fair shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. The La Plata County Fair Board shall not insure, nor be responsible for, the safety of animals or the person tending them. The signature on the entry form by the exhibitor and parent/guardian shall be deemed acceptance of all rules, including those on pages 6, 87, 88 & 95-98 and specific rules listed within individual departments, in the 2024 La Plata County Fair Premium Book. The exhibitor thereby indemnifies the La Plata County Fair from any and all legal proceedings in regard thereto.

CLASS X: MARKET/MEAT CLASS

All meat pen entries (3 birds) must be the same breed, same age, same sex and will be judged for meat quality only, pure breeds, commercial hybrids and cross breeds are acceptable.

A: Chicken Fryer Pen of 3 (12 weeks or younger, 13-18 lbs weight)

B: Chicken Roaster Pen of 3 (18 weeks or younger, 18-24 lbs weight)

C: Turkey Pen of 3 (20 weeks or younger)

D: Single Market Turkey (20 weeks or younger)

E: Duck Pen of 3 (12 weeks or younger, 18-24 lbs weight)
