As a participant in the La Plata County Fair Livestock Program, I will demonstrate my own ability, knowledge and skill in feeding, fitting and exhibiting animals. I will do my own work and only accept advice and support from others. I will not use abusive, questionable, illegal, or unethical techniques in feeding, fitting and exhibiting of my animal(s). I will not allow my parents, supervisors, and/or any other adult to employ such practices to my animal. I will read and follow all of the rules of the La Plata County Fair. I will also read and follow the Colorado State Law concerning the unlawful alteration of livestock, where applicable, by tampering or sabotage and the United State Department of Agriculture Wholesome Meat Act. I will ask that my parents and supervisors also understand and follow these rules and not make or ask for exceptions on my behalf. I wish for my animal project to be an example of how to accept what life has to offer – good or bad – and how to live with the outcome. I understand that I am responsible for the proper care and treatment of my animal, the production of wholesome food, where applicable, and the development of sound moral character.

The care, feeding, and safety of animals brought to the La Plata County Fair shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. The La Plata County Fair Board shall not insure, nor be responsible for, the safety of animals or the person tending them. The signature on the entry form by the exhibitor and parent/guardian shall be deemed acceptance of all rules, including those on pages 6-7, & 40-45 and specific rules listed within individual departments, in the 2026 La Plata County Fair Premium Book. The exhibitor therefore indemnifies the La Plata County Fair from any and all legal proceedings in regard thereto.

**La Plata County Fair Code of Conduct**

1. All participants and visitors shall conduct themselves in a courteous, respectful manner adhering to the rules of the fair, and the facility.
  2. There shall be no scooters, skateboards, rollerblades or bicycles allowed on any pedestrian sidewalk, under any coverings (patio, tents & pavilion) or in any building of the facility.
  3. Any harassment, physical, and/or verbal abuse or use of profanity toward any other person, during the fair, on the fairground's property is forbidden.
  4. Only service dogs with identifying coat or tag with a collar and leash are allowed in any building or pavilion. No other dogs are allowed in any building or pavilion.
- Consequences for violating any part of this code after being warned by any Fair Board member or Fairgrounds/Extension staff, at least two times, will be expulsion from the fair and fairgrounds.
