Open Class Entries

Return to the La Plata County Extension, 2500 Main Avenue, Durango, CO 81301. Entry forms and fees will be accepted between July 20 at 8 a.m. and July 24 at 5 p.m. (Checks should be made payable to: **La Plata County Fair, Inc.**) The Fair Board is assessing a stall fee of \$3.00 per animal. Late entries will be accepted if space permits with double entry fee.

The Open Class Beef Show is a haul in show. Limited pen space will be available in the Open Class Barn and will be issued on a first come, first served basis, based on returned entry forms (4-H & FFA entries will receive first priority). You are asked to clean out your stalls when you leave. Haul in animals should be on the grounds in time to be ready to show and may leave at the completion of the show.

The care, feeding, and safety of animals brought to the La Plata County Fair shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor. The La Plata County Fair Board shall not insure, nor be responsible for, the safety of animals or the person tending them. The signature on the entry form by the exhibitor and parent/guardian shall be deemed acceptance of all rules, including those on pages 6-7, & 40-45 and specific rules listed within individual departments, in the 2026 La Plata County Fair Premium Book. The exhibitor therefore indemnifies the La Plata County Fair from any and all legal proceedings in regard thereto.

La Plata County Fair Code of Conduct

1. All participants and visitors shall conduct themselves in a courteous, respectful manner adhering to the rules of the fair, and the facility.
 2. There shall be no scooters, skateboards, rollerblades or bicycles allowed on any pedestrian sidewalk, under any coverings (patio, tents & pavilion) or in any building of the facility.
 3. Any harassment, physical, and/or verbal abuse or use of profanity toward any other person, during the fair, on the fairground's property is forbidden.
 4. Only service dogs with identifying coat or tag with a collar and leash are allowed in any building or pavilion. No other dogs are allowed in any building or pavilion.
- Consequences for violating any part of this code after being warned by any Fair Board member or Fairgrounds/Extension staff, at least two times, will be expulsion from the fair and fairgrounds.
